

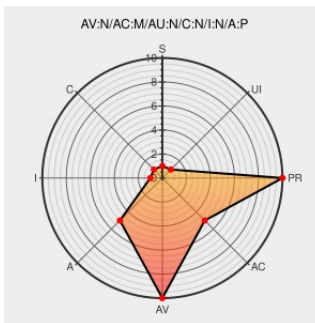

Certain versions of [Pyftplib](#) from [G.rodola](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Race condition in the FTPHandler class in ftpserver.py in pyftplib before 0.5.2 allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service (daemon outage) by establishing and then immediately closing a TCP connection, leading to the getpeername function having an ENOTCONN error, a different vulnerability than CVE-2010-3494.

CVE-2009-5011 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability
