This issue affects the function db_query of the file src/backend/include/BaseAction.php. The manipulation leads to sql injection. The identifier of the patch is

41213b660e8eb01b22c8074f06208f59a73ca8dc. It is recommended to apply a patch to fix this issue. The identifier VDB-218465 was assigned to this vulnerability. NOTE: This vulnerability only affects products that are no longer supported by the maintainer.
