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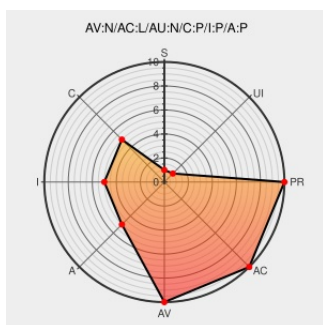

SQL injection vulnerability in casting_view.php in Modelbook allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the adnum parameter.
