Multiple directory traversal vulnerabilities in ProMan 0.1.1 and earlier allow remote attackers to include and execute arbitrary local files via directory traversal sequences in the `_SESSION[userLang]` parameter to (1) `elisttasks.php`, (2) `managemanagers.php`, (3) `manageusers.php`, (4) `helpfunc.php`, (5) `managegroups.php`, (6) `manageprocess.php`, and (7) `manageusersgroups.php`.
