

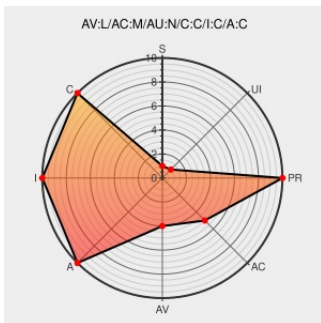

Certain versions of [Ust](#) from [Lttng](#) contain the following vulnerability: usttrace in LTTng Userspace Tracer (aka UST) 0.7 places a zero-length directory name in the LD_LIBRARY_PATH, which allows local users to gain privileges via a Trojan horse shared library in the current working directory.
