

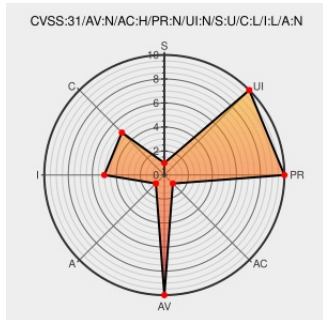

Certain versions of [Typo3](#) from [Typo3](#) contain the following vulnerability:

TYPO3 before 4.3.4 and 4.4.x before 4.4.1 contains insecure randomness during generation of a hash with the "forgot password" function.

CVE-2010-3670 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
