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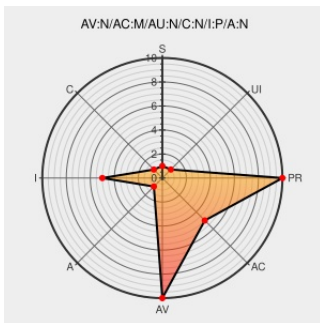

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in `advanced_search_result.php` in ALLPC 2.5 allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the `keywords` parameter.
