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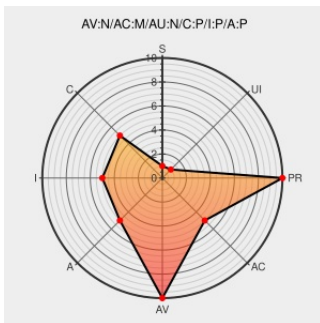

Certain versions of **ibrowser** from **Net4visions** contain the following vulnerability:

Directory traversal vulnerability in **ibrowser.php** in the **CMScout 2.09 IBrowser TinyMCE Plugin 1.4.1**, when **magic\_quotes\_gpc** is disabled, allows remote attackers to read arbitrary files via a **..** (dot dot) in the **lang** parameter. NOTE: some of these details are obtained from third party information.
