Certain versions of [Liferay Portal](#) from [Liferay](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Liferay Portal through 6.2.10 allows remote authenticated users to execute arbitrary shell commands via a crafted Velocity template.

CVE-2010-5327 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
