Description	Unspecified vulnerability in the Oracle Application Object Library component in Oracle E-Business Suite 11.5.10.2, 12.0.6, 12.1.2, 12.1.3, 12.2.6, and 12.3.1 that allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code or cause a denial of service (memory consumption) via a crafted SOAP request, as demonstrated with the SOAPAction header.
