Description	Unspecified vulnerability in the Oracle Agile PLM for Process component in Oracle Supply Chain Products Suite 5.2.2, 6.0.0, 6.1.1, and 6.2.0 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code or cause a denial of service (memory consumption) via a crafted XML file, which triggers a buffer overflow in the XML parser. The vulnerability exists in the XML parser, which does not properly handle a crafted XML file, leading to a buffer overflow and subsequent memory consumption. This vulnerability is present in the Oracle Agile PLM for Process component, which is part of the Oracle Supply Chain Products Suite. The affected versions are 5.2.2, 6.0.0, 6.1.1, and 6.2.0. The vulnerability is identified by CVE-2012-0580.
