

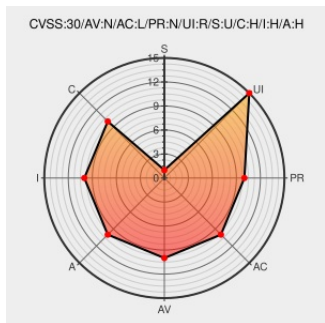


# CVE-2012-0771

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## CVE-2012-0771

Certain versions of [Shockwave Player](#) from [Adobe](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Adobe Shockwave Player before 11.6.4.634 allows attackers to execute arbitrary code or cause a denial of service (memory corruption) via unspecified vectors, a different vulnerability than CVE-2012-0759.

CVE-2012-0771 has been assigned by psirt@adobe.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
