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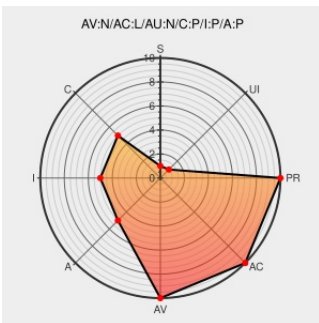

SQL injection vulnerability in system/src/dispatcher.php in Dir2web 3.0 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the oid parameter in a homepage action to index.php.
