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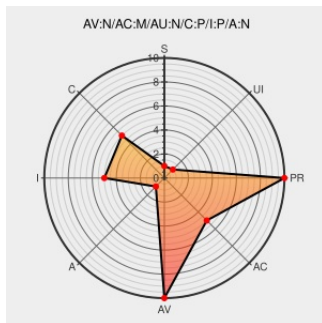

Open redirect vulnerability in JForum 2.1.9 allows remote attackers to redirect users to arbitrary web sites and conduct phishing attacks via a URL in the returnUrl parameter in a validateLogin action to `jforum.page`.
