

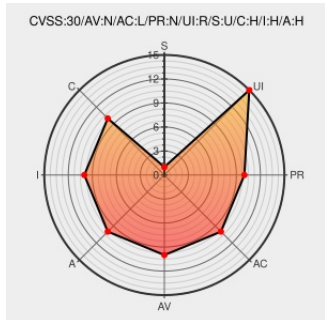

Certain versions of [Ffmpeg](#) from [Ffmpeg](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Libavcodec in FFmpeg before 0.11 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code via a crafted ASF file.
