

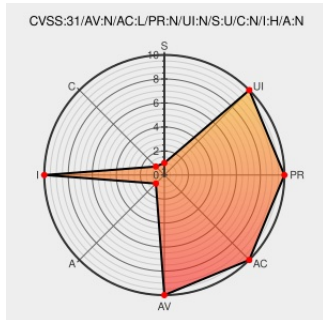

Certain versions of [Textproc/isearch](#) from [Openbsd](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The isearch package (textproc/isearch) before 1.47.01nb1 uses the tempnam() function to create insecure temporary files into a publicly-writable area (/tmp).

CVE-2012-5663 has been assigned by secalert@redhat.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
