

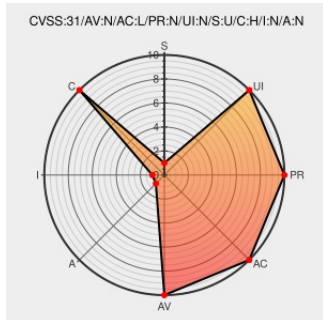

Certain versions of [Wordpress Exit Box Lite](#) from [Angrybyte](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability, which was classified as problematic, has been found in Exit Box Lite Plugin up to 1.06 on WordPress. Affected by this issue is some unknown functionality of the file wordpress-exit-box-lite.php. The manipulation leads to information disclosure. The attack may be launched remotely. Upgrading to version 1.10 is able to address this

issue. The name of the patch is fad26701addb862c51baf85c6e3cc136aa79c309. It is recommended to upgrade the affected component. The identifier of this vulnerability is VDB-230672.

CVE-2013-10030 has been assigned by [cna@vuldb.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
