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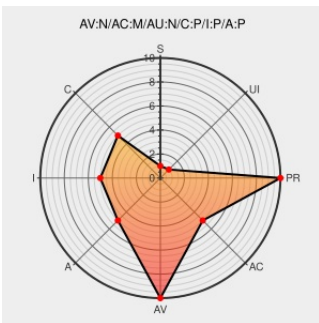

Cross-site request forgery (CSRF) vulnerability in the web interface in Cisco Prime Infrastructure allows remote attackers to hijack the authentication of arbitrary users, aka Bug ID CSCue84676.
