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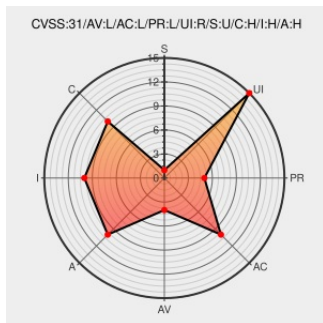

Certain versions of [Autojump](#) from [Autojump Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

autojump before 21.5.8 allows local users to gain privileges via a Trojan horse custom_install directory in the current working directory.

CVE-2013-2012 has been assigned by secalert@redhat.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **autojump** - **autojump** version = **before 21.5.8**
