

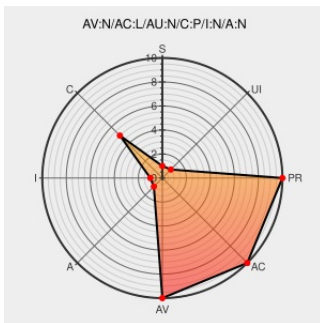

The configuration loader in ownCloud 5.0.x before 5.0.6 allows remote attackers to obtain CSRF tokens and other sensitive information by reading an unspecified JavaScript file.
