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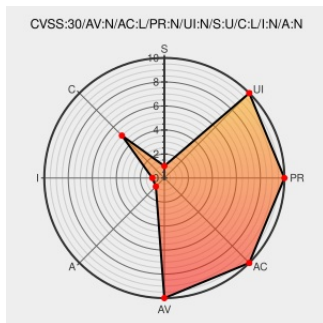

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Certain versions of [Tivoli Application Dependency Discovery Manager](#) from [Ibm](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The AXIS webapp in deploy-tomcat/axis in IBM Tivoli Application Dependency Discovery Manager (TADDM) 7.1.2 and 7.2.0 through 7.2.1.4 allows remote attackers to obtain sensitive configuration information via a direct request, as demonstrated by happyaxis.jsp. IBM X-Force ID: 84354.

CVE-2013-3018 has been assigned by [psirt@us.ibm.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
