

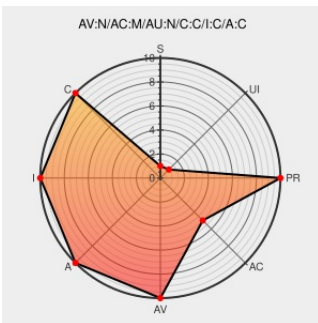

Certain versions of [Internet Explorer](#) from [Microsoft](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Microsoft Internet Explorer 6 through 8 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code or cause a denial of service (memory corruption) via a crafted web site, aka "Internet Explorer Memory Corruption Vulnerability."
