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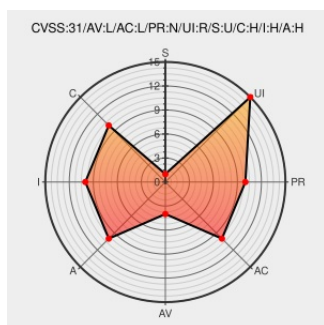

Certain versions of [Xnview](#) from [Xnview](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Heap-based buffer overflow in xnview.exe in XnView before 2.03 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code via a crafted RLE compressed layer in an XCF file.

CVE-2013-3247 has been assigned by PSIRT-CNA@flexerasoftware.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
