

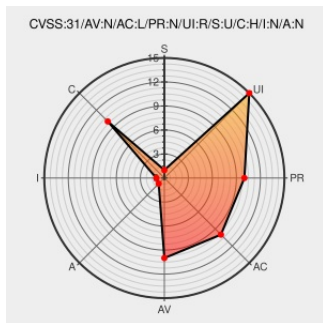

Certain versions of [Wnr3500l](#) from [Netgear](#) contain the following vulnerability:

NETGEAR WNR3500U and WNR3500L routers uses form tokens abased solely on router's current date and time, which allows attackers to guess the CSRF tokens.

CVE-2013-3516 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
