

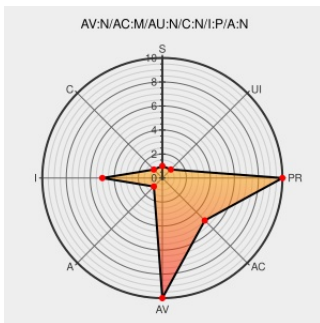

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in Corporater EPM Suite allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the customerId parameter to an unspecified component.
