

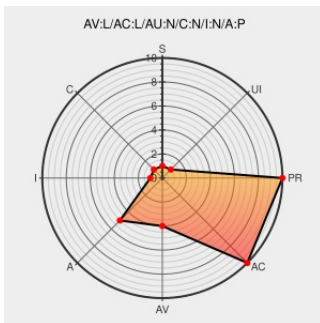

Certain versions of [Wimax Network Service](#) from [Intel](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The `Trace_OpenLogFile` function in

InfraStack/OSDependent/Linux/InfraStackModules/TraceModule/TraceModule.c in the Trace module in the Intel WiMAX Network Service through 1.5.2 for Intel Wireless WiMAX Connection 2400 devices uses world-writable permissions for `wimaxd.log`, which allows local users to cause a denial of service (data corruption) by modifying this file.
