

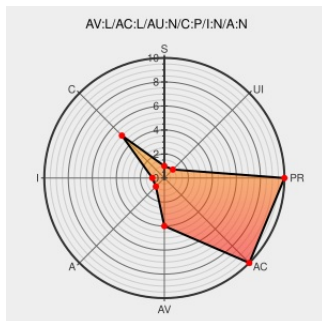

Certain versions of [Wimax Network Service](#) from [Intel](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The InitMethodAndPassword function in

InfraStack/OSAgnostic/WiMax/Agents/Supplicant/Source/SupplicantAgent.c in the Intel WiMAX Network Service through 1.5.2 for Intel Wireless WiMAX Connection 2400 devices uses the same RSA private key in supplicant_key.pem on all systems, which allows local users to obtain sensitive information via unspecified decryption operations.

CVE-2013-4218 has been assigned by secalert@redhat.com to track the vulnerability
