

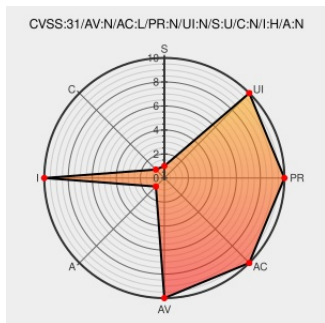

Certain versions of [Fedora](#) from [Fedoraproject](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The CentralNotice extension for MediaWiki before 1.19.9, 1.20.x before 1.20.8, and 1.21.x before 1.21.3 sets the Cache-Control header to cache session cookies when a user is autcreated, which allows remote attackers to authenticate as the created user.

CVE-2013-4572 has been assigned by secalert@redhat.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
