



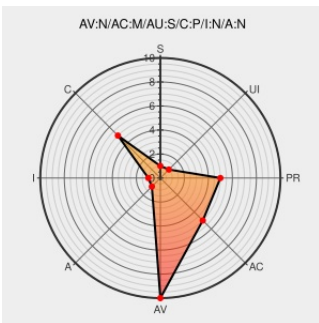

Zabbix 2.0.5 allows remote authenticated users to discover the LDAP bind password by leveraging management-console access and reading the `ldap_bind_password` value in the HTML source code.
