

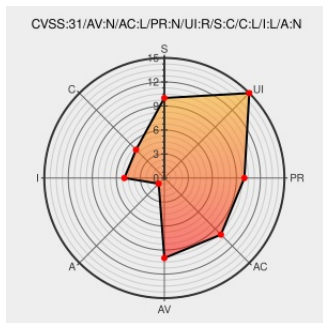

Certain versions of [Exis Contextis](#) from [Exis-ti](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in the photo gallery model in Exis Contextis before 2.0 allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the image parameter in a detail action.

CVE-2013-6239 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
