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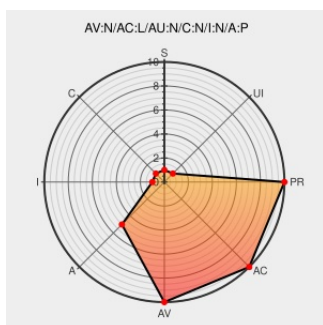

The SNMP module in Cisco IOS XR allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service (process reload) via a request for an unspecified MIB, aka Bug ID CSCuh43144.
