Description	Microsoft Internet Explorer 8 through 11 does not properly restrict file installation and registry-key creation, which allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code or cause a denial of service (memory consumption) via crafted HTML documents. This vulnerability is present in Internet Explorer 8 through 11, and in the Windows Internet Explorer component of Windows 8 through 10. Microsoft has released updates to address this issue. (CVE-2014-0268)
