Description	Microsoft Internet Explorer 6 through 10 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code or cause a denial of service (memory consumption) via crafted HTML documents, as demonstrated by the 'javascript:' URL scheme. This vulnerability is caused by a buffer overflow in the rendering engine. (CVE-2014-0269)
