

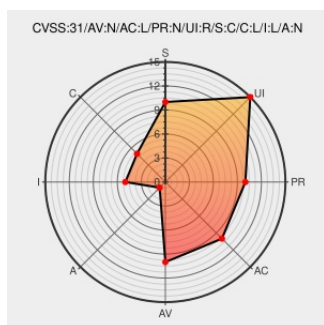

Certain versions of [Neoxplora](#) from [Neoxplora Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability, which was classified as problematic, has been found in kkokko NeoXplora. Affected by this issue is some unknown functionality of the component Trainer Handler. The manipulation leads to cross site scripting. The attack may be launched remotely. The name of the patch is dce1aec6ee050a29f953ffd8f02f21c7c13f1e6. It

is recommended to apply a patch to fix this issue. The identifier of this vulnerability is VDB-217352.

CVE-2014-125039 has been assigned by [cna@vuldb.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
