

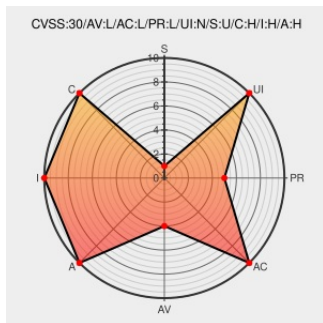

Certain versions of [Echor](#) from [Echor Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The `perform_request` function in `/lib/echor/backplane.rb` in echor 0.1.6 Ruby Gem allows local users to inject arbitrary code by adding a semi-colon in their username or password.

CVE-2014-1834 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
