Certain versions of [Subscribe To Comments Reloaded](#) from [Subscribe To Comments Reloaded Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cross-site request forgery (CSRF) vulnerability in the Subscribe To Comments Reloaded plugin before 140219 for WordPress allows remote attackers to hijack the authentication of administrators for requests that conduct cross-site scripting (XSS) attacks via a request to the subscribe-to-comments-reloaded/options/index.php page to wp-

admin/admin.php.

CVE-2014-2274 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
