

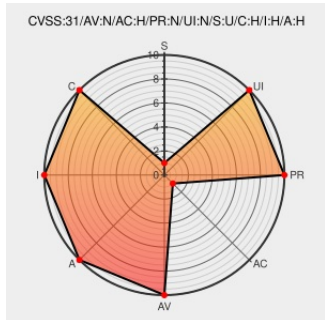

Certain versions of [Xmind](#) from [Xmind](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The update process in Xmind 3.4.1 and earlier allow remote attackers to execute arbitrary code via a man-in-the-middle attack.

CVE-2014-2680 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
