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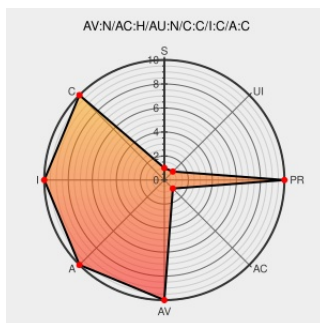

Certain versions of [Neutron](#) from [Openstack](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The default configuration in a sudoers file in the Red Hat openstack-neutron package before 2014.1.2-4, as used in Red Hat Enterprise Linux Open Stack Platform 5.0 for Red Hat Enterprise Linux 6, allows remote attackers to gain privileges via a crafted configuration file.

NOTE: this vulnerability exists because of a CVE-2013-6433

regression.
