

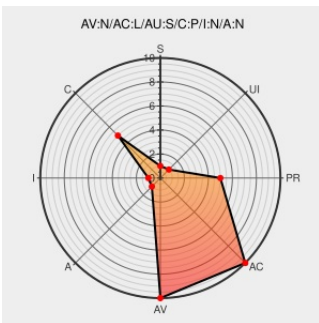

Certain versions of [Jenkins](#) from [Jenkins](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Jenkins before 1.583 and LTS before 1.565.3 allows remote authenticated users with the Job/READ permission to obtain the default value for the password field of a parameterized job by reading the DOM.
