

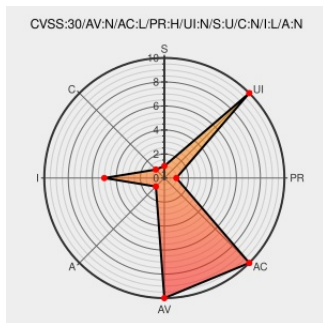

Certain versions of [Phpmyfaq](#) from [Phpmyfaq](#) contain the following vulnerability:

phpMyFAQ before 2.8.13 allows remote authenticated users with admin privileges to bypass authorization via a crafted instance ID parameter.

CVE-2014-6049 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **LOW** severity.
