Description	Microsoft Internet Explorer 6 through 10 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code or cause a denial of service (memory consumption) via crafted HTML documents, as demonstrated by a denial of service attack on a Windows 7 virtual machine. CVE-2014-6353 is a memory corruption vulnerability in the HTML rendering engine of Microsoft Internet Explorer 6 through 10. It allows a remote attacker to execute arbitrary code or cause a denial of service (memory consumption) via crafted HTML documents, as demonstrated by a denial of service attack on a Windows 7 virtual machine.
