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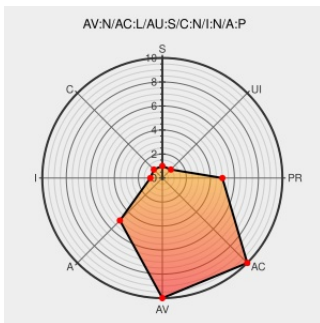

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Certain versions of [Asterisk](#) from [Digium](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The `res_pjsip_pubsub` module in Asterisk Open Source 12.x before 12.5.1 allows remote authenticated users to cause a denial of service (crash) via crafted headers in a SIP SUBSCRIBE request for an event package.
