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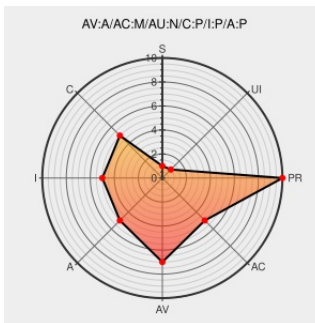

Certain versions of [Iras 59th Annual Conference](#) from [Core-apps](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The IRA's 59th Annual Conference (aka [com.coreapps.android.followme.ira\\_14](#)) application 6.0.7.6 for Android does not verify X.509 certificates from SSL servers, which allows man-in-the-middle attackers to spoof servers and obtain sensitive information via a crafted certificate.

CVE-2014-6912 has been assigned by cert@cert.org to track the vulnerability
