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Certain versions of [Georgia Packing](#) from [Gcspublishing](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Georgia Packing (aka [com.tapataalk.georgiapackingorg](#)) application 3.9.16 for Android does not verify X.509 certificates from SSL servers, which allows man-in-the-middle attackers to spoof servers and obtain sensitive information via a crafted certificate.
