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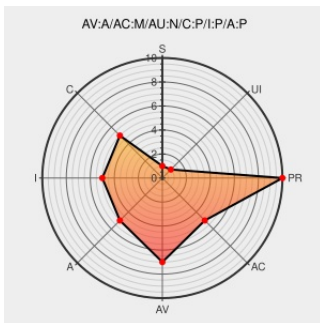

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Certain versions of [Coffee Inn](#) from [Coffee-inn](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Coffee Inn (aka [It.lemonlabs.android.coffeeinn](#)) application 2.0.1 for Android does not verify X.509 certificates from SSL servers, which allows man-in-the-middle attackers to spoof servers and obtain sensitive information via a crafted certificate.

CVE-2014-7012 has been assigned by cert@cert.org to track the vulnerability
