Certain versions of [Fabasoft Cloud](#) from [Fabasoft](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Fabasoft Cloud (aka com.fabasoft.android.cmis.folio\_cloud) application 3.0.1 for Android does not verify X.509 certificates from SSL servers, which allows man-in-the-middle attackers to spoof servers and obtain sensitive information via a crafted certificate.

CVE-2014-7560 has been assigned by cert@cert.org to track the vulnerability
