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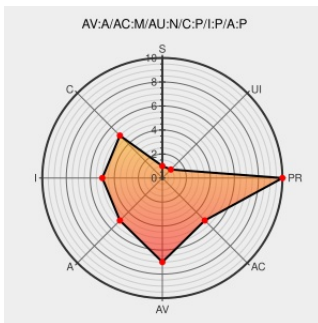

Certain versions of [Knights Of The Void](#) from [Narr8](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Knights of the Void (aka me.narr8.android.serial.knights\_of\_the\_void) application 2.1.7 for Android does not verify X.509 certificates from SSL servers, which allows man-in-the-middle attackers to spoof servers and obtain sensitive information via a crafted certificate.
