Certain versions of [Edeploy](#) from [Redhat](#) contain the following vulnerability:

eDeploy makes it easier for remote attackers to execute arbitrary code by leveraging use of HTTP to download files.

CVE-2014-8174 has been assigned by secalert@redhat.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
