

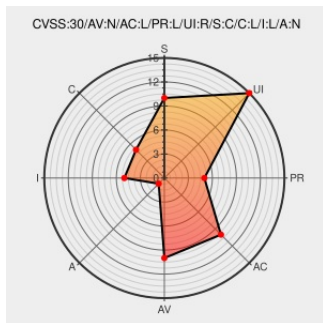

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in Jease 2.11 allows remote authenticated users to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via a content section note.
