

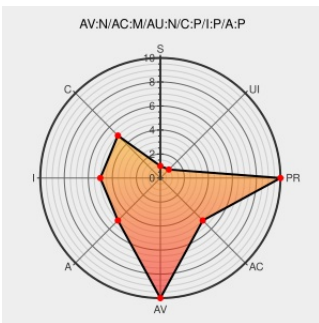

Certain versions of [Debian Linux](#) from [Debian](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Drupal 6.x before 6.34 and 7.x before 7.34 allows remote attackers to hijack sessions via a crafted request, as demonstrated by a crafted request to a server that supports both HTTP and HTTPS sessions.

CVE-2014-9015 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability
